General Objective:

Acquisition of 500 (five hundred) boxes for the transport of refrigerated vaccines

1. BACKGROUND

The Tripartite Project, created by signing the Memorandum of Understanding between Brazil, Cuba and Haiti, aims to strengthen the Haitian authorities in the area of health. This project is based on two main areas: strengthening the health system and Surveillance System (VE) in Haiti. The Surveillance area encompasses several actions, one being the strengthening of the Haitian Immunization Program, through acquisition of equipment for maintenance of cold chain and supplies, and of planning of immunization, assessment and monitoring activities.

The acquisition of equipment for the maintenance of cold chain aims to contribute to the Expanded Program on Immunization of the Ministry of Public Health and Population of Haiti strengthen the cold chain in the country enabling the delivery of quality vaccines to the population.

Two major vaccination campaigns are planned for the first half of April and July 2012 in Haiti. Thermal Boxes will be used to transport vaccines in large immunization activities. In some situations, the delivery of vaccines may occur in remote locations where travel may take longer than 96 hours.

Acquisition of 500 (five hundred) refrigerated boxes for transporting vaccines
